Notice of Race

The regatta will be organized and hosted by The San Francisco Yacht Club: 98 Beach Rd, Belvedere, CA.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), except in the event that anything is modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 All participants in this regatta shall wear a US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (PFD) at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing other clothing. Violation of this rule will result in a protest by the race committee, resulting in a protest committee decision up to disqualification from the entire regatta.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all boats that meet the International Optimist Class Rules.
- 2.2 **All competitors must enter by completing the online entry found at www.sfyc.org under On the Water > Regattas. A late fee of \$20 will apply after Wednesday, April 3. No entries will be accepted after Friday, April 5. There will be NO ON-SITE registration.**
- 2.3 There will be a Green fleet.
- 2.4 Red, White and Blue fleets will be determined by the USODA rules.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$60 and includes trophies for winners, on the water snacks, and after racing snacks.
- 3.2 Payment shall be made by credit card online at the time of registration.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions may be available online after 1800 hours on Wednesday, April 3. They will be available for pick up at the check-in desk.

6 Racing Venue

- 6.1 The primary race area for the Championship Fleet will be Southampton/Berkeley Circle. In the event of extreme conditions Richardson Bay or Belvedere Cove may be used as alternate race areas.
- 6.2 The Green Fleet will race in Belvedere Cove and will have a lunch break on shore.

7 The Courses

- 7.1 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions, and will be the "Opti Trapezoid" with an upwind finish for the Championship Fleet.

7.2 The green fleet will race windward/leeward and triangle courses, as announced at the green fleet meeting and on the water.

8 Scoring

8.1 When fewer than 5 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8.2 6 races are scheduled. 1 race will constitute a regatta.

9 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 Parking

Limited parking at The San Francisco Yacht Club will be available to competitors. Trailers will need to be parked in the south end of the lot as tightly together as possible. Coachboats may be launched at SFYC. Please see Forrest Gay or the Harbor staff to get docking instructions.
