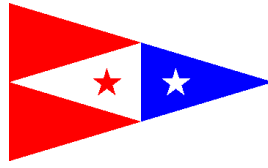

KNARR AND J/105 REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 For the J/105 fleet the J/105 Fleet One rules shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.4 Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) shall apply.
- 1.5 The sailing instructions may change additional racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The following classes are invited: Knarr and J/105
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration found at www.sfyc.org > On the Water > Regattas.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$135, if received by 1700 hours on May 29. The entry is \$185 after 1700 hours on May 29.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1600 hours on May 31.
- 2.5 If fewer than 5 boats in a fleet are entered by 1700 hours on May 29, SFYC may refund the entry fee and not provide a start for that fleet.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 Saturday – Three (3) races are scheduled with the first warning signal at 1200 hours.
- 3.2 Sunday – Two (2) races are scheduled with the first warning signal at 1200 hours.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on May 29, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on the website, www.sfyc.org.

5 VENUE

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle.

6 COURSES AND MARKS

The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions. All marks will be inflatable buoys.

7 SCORING

7.1 Two races must be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.

8 BERTHING

The SFYC guest dock will be available from May 31 through June 2.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 65A for on the water communication with the race committee.

9.2 Except in an emergency, or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
