Notice of Race

The 2019 BAYS Regatta #3 is organized and hosted by The San Francisco Yacht Club.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), each class' class rules, and this notice of race, except in the event that any of these are modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 **All participants in this regatta shall wear a US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (PFD) relying solely on foam for flotation at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing other clothing.** Violation of this rule may result in a protest by the race committee, and a decision by the protest committee up to disqualification from the entire regatta.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is open to the following classes: C420, CFJ (non-spinnaker), Laser Fullrig, Laser Radial, RS Tera, Optimist Championship Fleet, and Optimist Green Fleet. Fleets of fewer than 5 boats may be started with another fleet.
- 2.2 **All competitors shall enter by completing the online entry found at www.sfyc.org under On the Water > Regattas by Thursday, August 1. A late fee of \$20 will apply after Tuesday, July 30. There will be NO ON-SITE registration, and no registrations will be accepted after Thursday, August 1.**

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$40 per competitor and includes food for on the water, and snacks after racing each day.
- 3.2 Payment shall be made by credit card online.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available online after 1700 hours on Wednesday, July 31. They will also be

available for pick up at the check-in desk.

6 Racing Venue

- 6.1 The primary race area for the C420, opti championship, and laser classes will be the Southampton Shoals area. Racing may be moved to Richardson Bay depending on weather conditions.
- 6.2 The Opti Green Fleet, RS Tera, and CFJs will race in Belvedere Cove and will have lunch on shore.

7 The Courses

The courses will be windward-leeward type course and will be described in the sailing instructions.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 When fewer than 5 races are completed a boat's series scores will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.2 6 races are scheduled. 1 race will constitute a regatta.

9 Support Boats

Except in the case of emergency, support and spectator boats shall remain a distance of 100 yards from the racing area at all times, and shall not cause significant wake in the racing area.

10 Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top three finishers in each fleet, including Opti red, white and blue fleets.

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
