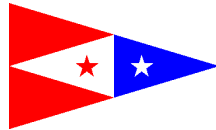

## SFYC MULTIHULL REGATTA

September 28 – 29, 2019

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may change additional racing rules.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: F18, Nacra 15.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org) > On the Water > Regattas.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$80, if received by 1700 hours on September 25. The entry fee will become \$100 after 1700 hours on September 25.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1700 hours on September 27.
- 2.5 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1700 hrs on September 25, SFYC may refund the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

#### **4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after September 25 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on the website, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

## **5 RACING AREA AND COURSES**

- 5.1 The racing area will be in the vicinity of Southampton Shoals on Saturday, and either Southampton Shoals or Knox on Sunday. The Sunday location will be posted on the Notice Board by 1800 hours on Saturday.
- 5.2 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions, and be windward/leeward type.

## **6 SCORING**

- 6.1 Six races are scheduled. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 If five or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be total of her race scores excluding her worst.
- 6.3 If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

## **7 BERTHING**

The guest docks will be available for boats that wish to stay in the water on Saturday night.

## **8 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 8.1 Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 65A for on the water communication with the race committee.
- 8.2 Except in an emergency, or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **9 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.

## **10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
